

## New ICRC Resource for States with D-SNPs Affected by Rules at 42 CFR § 422.514(h)

The Integrated Care Resource Center (ICRC) recently released [a new tip sheet](#) for states with D-SNPs affected by the rules at 42 CFR § 422.514(h). These rules, which take effect in 2027 and 2030, apply to D-SNPs operated by parent organizations that also operate a comprehensive Medicaid managed care organization (MCO) that enrolls full-benefit dually eligible individuals in the same (or overlapping) service areas as the D-SNP.

The ICRC tip sheet supplements a [frequently asked questions document](#) issued by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). In the tip sheet, states can find:

- An overview of the requirements at 42 CFR § 422.514(h) and a summary of rule exceptions,
- Illustrative examples and options for D-SNP compliance with each rule provision,
- Action steps for states in working with D-SNPs to ensure compliance with these new rules, and
- Sample contract language that states may wish to incorporate into their state Medicaid agency contracts (SMACs) with D-SNPs affected by these rules.
